



Taft-Diaz Meeting



El Paso, Texas-Juarez, Mexico.

October 15, 1909

JUAREZ

President Porfirio Diaz, who will arrive in Juarez on the afternoon of October 15 will spend the night in the residence of the late Ynocente Ochoa.

Accompanying the president will be Jose Limantour, minister of finance; minister Mariscal, of foreign affairs; Gen. Manuel Gonzales C. sio, minister of war and Enrique C. Creel, Governor of the State of Chihuahua.

Four vehicles of the landau type and ten blooded horses from the private stables of president Porfirio Diaz have arrived in Juarez from Chapultepec castle. The president of Mexico will ride in his own gold trimmed vehicle from the federal building to the international border.

MAXIMILIAN PLATE AT THE BANQUET

Historic and famed service to be used at Ciudad Juarez. Historic and famed plate and China which composed a part of the banquet service of emperor Maximilian, will be brought from Mexico City for the banquet which president Diaz will tender to President Taft at 5:30 p. m., October 16th.

The service is composed of several thousand pieces and is said to compare favorably in richness and splendor with the famed sets of the old world royalty.

Nothing will be left undone by the Mexican Government and no expense will be spared in making the reception of the president of the United States one of the most memorable events in the history of the Diaz administration.

At this banquet, which will be attended by the presidential parties, military officers of high rank, state official, city officials of El Paso and Juarez and other invited guests, only two toasts will be offered. The toast of President Diaz will be responded to by President Taft.
