

MRS. O. H. BAUM PASSES AWAY AT HIGHLAND PARK

Death Resulted From Gangrenous Appendicitis — A Woman Dies on Incoming G. H. Train.

Mrs. Nannie Baum, wife of O. H. Baum, died this morning at the family home, Memphis and Courchesne streets, Altura Park. Death was caused by gangrenous appendicitis, following an illness of several weeks. Miss Nannie Foy was born in Genosee, Ill., 43 years ago and was married in 1869 at Manhattan, Kansas, to O. H. Baum. In company with her husband she moved to El Paso about 12 years ago, where she had since resided. She was a member of the Episcopal church and its auxiliaries and had also been an active worker for civic improvements. Her husband and one brother, Andrew Foy, at Arkansas City, survive her. There were no children. The date for the funeral has not been set, it depending on word from relatives of Mr. Baum, who have been wired. McBean, Simmons & Carr have charge of the funeral.
