Funeral services for H. F. Bennett, pioneer El Paso lawyer, who died yesterday at his home, 528 Prospect avenue, will be held Thursday at 10 a. m. at Holy Family Chapel. He was 69. Rev. Father J. C. M. Garde will officiate.

Rosary services will be held today at 7:30 p. m. at Kaster and Maxon Mortuary.

Mr. Bennett was the son of Col. J. E. Bennett. He was born in Old Mesilla. He was graduated from the Washington Law school and went to Mexico City as secretary to his father, who was then American Consul. He practiced law in El Paso from 1899 to 1917 when he went to Madrid, Spain, as assistant trade commissioner. He returned to El Paso in 1933.

Survivors are his widow, three sons, including H. J. and Roy Bennett of El Paso, two brothers and a sister. Burial will be in Concordia cemetery.
