

Israel E. Blaugrund Taken by Death

Israel E. Blaugrund, a resident of El Paso since 1921, died today at the home of his son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Max Grossman of 1610 North Stanton street.

Mr. Blaugrund came to El Paso from Czechoslovakia, where he had resided during his entire business career, to be near his sons and daughters.

He was born in Czechoslovakia in 1880. He was 84.

Two of his sons, Arthur and Joe Blaugrund, own the American Furniture Store and have been prominent for years in the business life of El Paso.
