Mrs. Elizabeth R. Booth, 1009 North Stanton Street, pioneer El Paso resident, died early Tuesday in a local hospital.

She came to El Paso from St. Louis, Mo., as the bride of the late D. C. Booth, former City and County purchasing agent, and well known El Paso business man. He died in March, 1940.

Mrs. Booth was a charter member of the Woman's Club, an active member of the Robert E. Lee Chapter of the United Daughters of the Confederacy, and of the Woman's Circle work of the First Presbyterian Church.
