

**DEATH OF A. E. BRANDEN-  
BERRY BELOW THIS CITY.**

**Was Manager of the El Paso Dairy  
Company's Ranch in the Valley Be-  
low El Paso.**

A. E. Brandenberry, aged 43 years, died at the ranch of the El Paso Dairy company, eight miles below the city, yesterday afternoon at four o'clock, and McBean & Simmons have the remains preparing them for shipment to the old home in Paola, Kansas.

Mr. Brandenberry had been in this vicinity for five years. Before he came here he was a trusted employe of a large wagon concern in Chicago, but owing to ill health was forced to come to this climate.

He has had charge of the dairy company's ranch ever since that concern owned it, and for two years previous to that, and Manager Smith says that his services have been the best possible ever since he has been with the company.

While at work connecting up the wells for irrigation last January Mr. Brandenberry contracted a severe cold which finally developed into pneumonia, and which resulted in his death. His father and mother were telegraphed to come here from their home in Kansas, but only the father could come, and he got here last Tuesday. The father will accompany the remains to their last resting place. His mother will come to Dodge City, Kan., and accompany the remains to Paola.

Mr. Brandenberry was a brother of Mrs. M. L. Cadwallader, of this city.
