Funeral services for George W. Brittingham, retired Chihuahua City merchant, who died Wednesday in El Paso, will be held at 10 a. m. tomorrow at St. Patrick's cathedral, with Rev. Fr. D. J. Kirgan officiating.

Mr. Brittingham was 74. He was an El Paso pioneer, a member of the famous old McGinty Club, and an Elk.
