This morning at 2 o'clock Mr. Frank P. Brown breathed his last at his residence No. 109 El Paso street. Six weeks ago Mr. Brown contracted a cold from which he suffered inconveniences, until Sunday morning, when he expressed himself as being on the road to recovery, but Sunday night he was taken worse, lobula pneumonia having been developed so that his physicians abandoned hope.

Mr. Brown for the past eight years conducted the drug business at 108 El Paso street; stood well as a citizen, and a business man and was in every respect a valued friend.

Undertaker Powell has charge of the remains and will ship the remains tomorrow to San Jose, Cal., where the surviving members of the family reside. Dr. Vilas, the physician and friend of Mr. Brown, will accompany Mrs. Brown to California where the final interment is to be made.
