

John J. Bruck, Former Pasoan, Dies On Coast

Word was received here yesterday by Mrs. Arthur Hewitt of the death of John J. Bruck, former El Pasoan, in Hollywood, Calif. He was 71 years old.

Mr. Bruck was well known among early settlers in El Paso and lived here until 1918 when he retired and went to California.

Coming to El Paso from Hamilton, Ohio, in 1881, he was associated at first with the old El Paso Gas company, later joining Coles Bros., with whom he worked nine years. During his residence in El Paso, he also was connected with banks of the city.

He is survived by Mrs. Hewitt, his niece, of El Paso; a nephew, Robert Henn, formerly employed in El Paso banks and now living in Hollywood; and two sisters, Mrs. Robert Henn, of Los Angeles, and Miss Emeline Bruck of Hamilton, Ohio.

Mrs. Hewitt left last night for Hollywood to attend the funeral.
