

MRS. BUCHANAN PASSES AWAY

**Widow of S. H. Buchanan,
One of the Pioneers of
El Paso.**

Mrs. Irene Buchanan, widow of S. H. Buchanan, a pioneer of El Paso, died Saturday night at 710 Mesa avenue. The deceased was born at Ashtabula, Ohio, July 5, 1839, and is survived by Mrs. A. R. Howard, who lived with her, and six other sisters living in different parts of the country.

Mrs. Buchanan had made her home in El Paso for the past 27 years. S. H. Buchanan at one time was in the contracting business in El Paso and conducted the Buchanan planing mill.

Later the firm became known as Buchanan & Powers, Frank Powers of this city, being identified with Mr. Buchanan.

The funeral will be held Wednesday and interment will be made in Concordia cemetery. The hour of the funeral, which will be conducted by McBean, Simmons & Carr, has not been set.
