ALAMOGORDO, N.M.—Funeral services for Jay F. Cadwallader, 96, member of a pioneer Southwestern family who died here late Friday, will be held at 12:30 p.m. Sunday in Mullins-Hamilton Funeral Home.

A native of Louisburg, Kan., Mr. Cadwallader moved with his parents, the late Mr. and Mrs. Edgar Francis Cadwallader, in 1892 to the Lower Valley of El Paso where they farmed for many years. Cadwallader Elementary School was named for the Cadwallader family.

Mr. Cadwallader moved to Mountain Park, N.M., in 1902 where he operated his orchards and farms. He then moved to La Luz where he resided until his death.

He was a member of the Methodist Church.

Survivors are two nieces, Mrs. Virginia Cadwallader Randel of El Paso and Mrs. Martha Curtis of Las Cruces, N.M., three nephews, Edgar A. Cadwallader of Silver Springs, Md., James K.
