

CIVIL WAR DRUMMER BOY DIES IN EL PASO

**Spanish Vets And Masons In Charge
of Funeral Tomorrow**

John Leslie Campbell, 85, who was a drummer boy with the New Jersey unit of the northern army of the Civil war, died today at the home of his daughter Mrs. H. E. Wilson, 501 E. California. He also is survived by a son, W. W. Campbell, Los Angeles.

He had been a Mason for the last 60 years.

Funeral services will be held tomorrow at 4 p. m. at Kaster & Maxon chapel.
