

Edward A. Caples Taken by Death

Edward A. Caples, born in El Paso 70 years ago, died today in his home at Roseway road, Lower Valley. He was the son of the late Richard Caples, mayor of El Paso from 1889 to 1893.

Mr. Caples was a contractor like his father, who constructed the Caples building.

During the last few years he managed the family's real estate interests. He served as County Tax Assessor in 1901 and 1902.

He was a member of St. Patrick's Cathedral.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Edward A. Caples; three daughters, Elizabeth, Emma and Margaret; three sons, Edward Jr., Richard and Robert, all of El Paso; and two brothers, William of Dallas and Joseph of Phoenix. Funeral arrangements are pending with Hagedorn-Harding and Orr Funeral Home.
