

WILLIAM CAPLES ROSARY SERVICE

Death Takes Pioneer, Former Police Chief

A rosary service will be held at 7:30 p. m. today at Hartford Mortuary Chapel for William Caples, pioneer El Pasoan and former Police Chief.

Mr. Caples was 77. He died yesterday at his home at 315 Upson Ave. He had been a resident of El Paso 56 years.

Mr. Caples came to El Paso in 1881 and was a bridge and stonework contractor. He served as Police Chief from 1890 to 1892. Later Mr. Caples became a local member of the U. S. Treasury Department. He was in that service until 1926.

Funeral services will be held at 10 a. m. tomorrow from Immaculate Conception Church. Rev. Fr. C. M. Garde will officiate.

Surviving Mr. Caples are his widow, Mrs. Mamee C. Caples, two sons, William C. Caples and Osmond Caples, all of El Paso, and a daughter, Mrs. Mary C. McGrady, Crawford, N. J.
