

N. H. Carson Dead; Pioneer of El Paso

N. H. Carson, 64, pioneer of El Paso and a pioneer member of the Elks' club here, died Friday night in the home of his son, Dewey Carson, in Los Angeles, according to word received here yesterday.

Mr. Carson is survived by his widow, Mrs. Lydia Carson, and two grandchildren, in addition to his son.

He was born in Maryland and came to El Paso more than 40 years ago. For many years he was engaged in the cement contracting business here and left only recently to make his home with his son who left El Paso about two years ago to go into the contracting business in Los Angeles.

Mr. Carson was a member of the Pioneers' association. Funeral arrangements have not yet been announced.
