S. C. Castillo, age thirty-two years, died at his residence on North Santa Fe street yesterday and the body was prepared for shipment by McBean & Simmons, to Socorro, N. M., where interment will be made.

Mr. Castillo was a very prominent Mexican in this city, having been confidential clerk to E. M. Bray at the smelter for the past six years. He had also run for district clerk twice and had made a fine showing each time.

He was president of the smelter branch of the S. M. M. La Beneficia, which lodge, together with the S. M. M. La Constructora and S. U. M., held funeral services at the parlors. The body was then removed to the Sacred Heart church where funeral services were held last night; the three societies accompanied the remains to the Santa Fe train, where several short speeches were made, telling of the many good deeds the deceased had done during his life.
