

# Mrs. Beulah Claunch Taken By Death

Mrs. Beulah Young Claunch, wife of L. H. Claunch, prominent cattleman at Granquivira, N. M., died today in a hospital. She was 68.

Mrs. Claunch was a graduate of the University of Texas, where she was a Phi Beta Kappa. She was outstanding as an educator, having assisted in compiling text books for Texas schools.

After coming to El Paso, Mrs. Claunch was associated with the Two Republics Life Insurance Co. for several years. When she married, Mr. Claunch was owner of the famous old Pueblo Pardo ranch at Granquivira.

Mrs. Claunch was placed at the head of schools in Granquivira. She was the first president of the Granquivira Opportunity Club there.

Mrs. Claunch with her husband had been spending the winter in El Paso at the home of his daughter, Mrs. W. T. Tolbert of 2209 Pittsburgh avenue.

She is survived by her husband; a sister, Mrs. Anna Edens of Austin; three brothers, Walter Young of Alto, George Young of Rusk, and John Young of Laford.

Funeral services will be held at 10 a. m. Monday in the Kaster and Maxon Chapel with Rev. I. L. Yearby officiating. Burial will be in Evergreen Cemetery.
