

## **Mrs. Coles. Longtime Resident, Dies**

Mrs. A. P. Coles, prominent social and civic leader, died in her home 800 Magoffin Ave. late Friday night.

She had been ill for the past four months.

The pioneer El Paso resident was the widow of the late A. P. Coles, El Paso builder who died several years ago.

Up until the last few years, Mrs. Coles took active part in all civic and social affairs in the city. She held the chairmanship of the Symphony Orchestra Committee, which supported all activities of the El Paso Symphony Orchestra, and was one of the leading patrons of the group.

She also was former president of the El Paso Branch of the National Plant, Flower and Fruit Guild.

The former Miss Nelleye Bell, she was married to Mr. Coles in the Trinity Methodist Church by the Rev. C. J. Oley, in January, 1893.
