

FATHER OF WINCHESTER COOLEY CALLED BY DEATH

M. L. Cooley, 75, retired business man of Las Vegas, N. M., and father of Winchester Cooley, president of the Rio Grande Valley Bank & Trust company died at his home in Las Vegas, Sunday morning. The funeral will be held Monday afternoon.

Decedent was ill for four years, this being the reason for his retirement from the livery business, in which he had been engaged for many years. When his condition became critical, a week ago, his son Winchester, left El Paso to visit him, and was with him when he died. He was a pioneer of the southwest, having come to Las Vegas from Attica, N. Y., 40 years ago.

Besides his son, he is survived by his widow, and daughter Elizabeth, who lives at the family residence, Las Vegas.
