

HARRY CORNING.

Harry Corning, a well-known contractor, died Tuesday morning at 6:30 o'clock at 223 Porfirio Diaz street.

He had been ill for a number of months, having never fully recovered from a surgical operation performed several months ago. Mr. Corning was a member of the Elks and a 32nd degree Mason. He had lived in Texas 25 years, and has been in El Paso for about five years. Surviving him are a son, George, and a daughter, Stella, in El Paso; three sisters and a brother in New York city, and a brother in Alaska. His wife died in December, 1910. Mr. Corning was 41 years old.

The funeral will probably be held Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock.
