

Dr. W. A. Corson.

Dr. Walter A. Corson, aged 33 years, an inspector of customs at the local port and proprietor of Corson's book store on Mesa avenue, died last night from a hemorrhage. The remains of deceased are in charge of Nagle & Carr and will be shipped to the old home at Atlantic City, N. J. Mr. Corson came to El Paso a little less than three years ago, for the benefit of his health and soon purchased the Dellquest book store on Mesa avenue. Three months ago he was appointed to the position of customs inspector by collector Garrett. Since that time Mrs. Corson has conducted the store. Mr. Corson was apparently improving rapidly in this climate and none of his friends looked for death to claim him so soon. However, a violent hemorrhage overtook him last evening and the end soon came. Besides his wife, the deceased leaves one child. Before his health failed him Dr. Corson was a practicing physician in Atlantic City.
