

PIONEER WOMAN OF CITY DIES

Mrs. Alfred Courchesne, a Native of Chihuahua, Leaves Big Family.

Mrs. Sederiana Courchesne, aged 49, wife of Alfred Courchesne, prominent property owner and pioneer of El Paso, died Thursday morning at 8 o'clock, at the family residence near the Courchesne quarry. Private funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 3 o'clock, at the chapel of McBean, Simmons and Hartford. Rev. J. H. Fitzgerald will officiate. Interment will be made in Concordia cemetery Masonic plot.

Mrs. Courchesne was born in Chihuahua, Mex., coming to El Paso when she was 19 years of age. She is survived by eight children. The sons are Thomas, Albert, John and William, all residing here. The daughters are Mrs. R. A. Smith, this city; Mrs. John J. Holland, of Globe, Ariz., and the Misses Josephine and Madeleine Courchesne.
