Died, on December 26, at 11:20 p. m. at the residence of her son, J. C. Critchett, Clint, Texas, Mrs. Myra W. Critchett, aged sixty-three years. though the health of Mrs. Critchett has been slightly impaired for a number of years, yet her sudden death comes as a great shock to her many friends and relatives. While she had been suffering for several days, her condition was not deemed serious until late Christmas day when the alarming symptoms of pnuemonia appeared, and in her weakened condition all that skilled medical aid and loving hands could do, was of no avail against the ravages of the dread destroyer.
