

Miss Yndita Crosby Is Victim of Death

Word was received Wednesday of the death of Miss Yndita Z. Crosby, formerly of El Paso, in her home at East Hampton, N. Y., following an illness of three weeks. She is survived by four sisters, Mesdames M. C. Wood and Virginia C. Moran, both of New York city; Kathleen C. Amor, of Mexico City and Mrs. M. C. Hardcastle, of Houston, Texas.

Miss Crosby was the daughter of judge and Mrs. J. F. Crosby, pioneer El Pasoans. The present site of the Federal Reserve bank was the Crosby home during the 80's Mrs. Josephine Crosby, and family left El Paso during 1912 and have lived in New York since that time. Funeral services will be held in East Hampton Friday afternoon, according to advice received by D. C. Crowell.
