

**FUNERAL OF
W. T. CYRUS**

**Typographical Union Con-
ducts the Ceremony—
Other El Paso Deaths**

The funeral of W. T. Cyrus, the printer, who died at the home of his mother, Mrs. E. B. Cyrus, 503 Boulevard, Monday morning, will be held at 4 o'clock this afternoon from the residence. After a short service at the house the body will be removed to the First Baptist church and the regular funeral service conducted by the Rev. Robert Bruce Smith, pastor.

El Paso Typographical Union No. 370 of which the deceased was a member, will participate in the funeral. The following named, who were intimate friends of the deceased and with whom he worked on the various newspapers of the city, will act as pall bearers: H. S. Maple, Everett Foster, John Kuhn, C. W. Van Loan, Joseph Eastburn and C. E. Hensley.

Deceased leaves but two relatives in El Paso, his mother, Mrs. E. B. Cyrus, and his brother-in-law, John M. Wyatt. His father, who was at one time one of the largest cotton dealers in the south, died some years ago, and his sister, Mrs. J. M. Wyatt, died shortly after the family came to this city to make their home.

Interment will be made in Evergreen cemetery.
