

Elijah C. Dawley Claimed By Death

Elijah Curtis Dawley, a former pioneer resident of El Paso, died at his home, 1301 Kanawha street, Charleston, W. Va., Monday evening, according to information received yesterday by B. G. Thomas, 1000 North Stanton street.

Dawley was associated in business with W. G. Walz, Sr., and later served in the customs service under the late Judge Joseph Magoffin. He came to El Paso in 1882.

He married Miss Florrie Rand, daughter of Mayor and Mrs. Noyes Rand. Both were popular in early El Paso social circles.

Dawley is survived by his widow and two sons.
