

# W. W. Deerman Taken by Death

W. W. Deerman of Canutillo died today in a hospital. He was 79.

Mr. Deerman had been a farmer in the Upper Valley for 30 years. He was born in 1874 in Penton, Ala., and moved to Indian Territory, Okla., where he farmed and ranched. He raised thoroughbred cattle there for 20 years.

Mr. Deerman came to the El Paso area in 1924 where he was active on his farm, four miles west of Canutillo until 10 years ago.

He was a member of Masonic Lodge 395 in Blanchard, Okla., for 46 years.

Survivors include two sons, Joe of Canutillo and Charles of El Paso, a daughter, Mrs. Jack Cox of Anthony, one brother, R.
