

## **PIONEER RESIDENT OF THE CITY DIES**

### **Mrs. D. E. Doane Passes Away After a Long Ill- ness; Aged 73 Years.**

Mrs. Fannie L. Doane, 73 years old and a 27 years' resident of El Paso, died Sunday evening at her home, 1021 Magoffin avenue. She had been ill for many months, and an invalid for many years. About two years ago she sustained serious injuries in a fall at her home.

Mrs. Doane came to El Paso from Ann Arbor, Mich, with her husband, Delvan E. Doane, a large real estate owner in this city and known by all the older business fraternity. She was a charter member of the First Methodist church, and was very active in its earlier history in the parochial organizations. Besides the husband surviving are three daughters, Mrs. W. W. Fink, Mrs. Ella B. Howe, register clerk, and Miss Maud B. Doane, stamp clerk, both of the El Paso postoffice. Also she is survived by two sisters, Mrs. F. E. Cleveland, of Hartford, Conn., and Mrs. D. J. Merriman, of Painesville, O.

Mrs. Doane lived for some time at Clint, Texas, where her husband had a large ranch. Funeral services will be held at 4 o'clock Tuesday at the residence, Rev. C. O. Beckman officiating.
