

SAM DREBEN'S DAUGHTER DIES

Hurried Trip to Cloudercroft Fails to Save Her; Father Arrives From Camp.

Cloudercroft, N. M., June 19.—Helen, the infant daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Sam Dreben, of 2416 Montana street, El Paso, died here early this morning at the baby sanatorium. The child was brought here Sunday by the mother and Dr. Branch Craige, very seriously ill, in the hope of saving her life, but the little one was too weak and too far gone to be saved.

Mr. Dreben, who is serving in the army at Fort Worth, was summoned by telegraph and arrived on the train yesterday afternoon, a few hours before the little daughter passed away. The bereaved parents left on today's train for El Paso with the remains of their little one.

The funeral services will be held there. Helen was born January 23 last.

Though over the draft age, Mr. Dreben voluntarily enlisted in the army a short time after the birth of his baby, and had only been home on one furlough since enlisting, until called to bid the little one a last farewell.
