

Emilio Duchesne Dead.

Emilio Duchesne, the well known veteran of the Mexican war, died at his Juarez residence at 10 o'clock last night, aged 65, and will be buried at 3 p. m. Padre Ortiz officiating.

Mr. Duchesne was one of the best known men in this part of the country, particularly among U. S. army officers, and visiting officers always have made it a point to go over the river to see the old veteran. He served in the United States army from 1846 to 1856, being honorably discharged in the latter year.

For the last thirty years Mr. Duchesne has been a resident of Juarez, as he married a Mexican wife, as did many other old soldiers at that time. He has kept himself informed about every thing going on in army and navy circles, and was one of the best posted men on such things. He was of most excellent character, a genial disposition, and very agreeable socially. The funeral will be largely attended.
