Henry C. Dyer of 1307 Cincinnati street, retired real estate dealer, died in a hospital today. He was 76 and had been a resident of El Paso for 43 years.

A native of Fayetteville, Tenn., he attended Morgan College in Howell, Tenn. He later taught mathematics at Fayetteville before moving to El Paso in 1907.

He joined the late John Roseborough in forming the Roseborough-Dyer Realty Co. He took over the firm following Mr. Roseborough's death.

He was a member of the Masonic Fraternity Lodge No. 1111 and a member of First Presbyterian Church.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Elizabeth Dyer; a son, Clay of El Paso; two daughters, Mrs. Betty Dyer of El Paso and Mrs. Robert Dygert of Rochester, N. Y., and two sisters, Mrs. Sam Wakefield and Mrs. John Tigue, both of Fayetteville.
