

ALEXANDER EDGERTON DIES; SON OF FORMER U. S. CONSUL

Alexander Edgerton, for many years a resident of Juarez and El Paso, died Sunday at the residence of Louis Fenchler on South Oregon street. He was born in Juarez 40 years ago, a son of the American consul in Juarez at that time. After completing his education in El Paso, Mr. Edgerton went into the jewelry business in Juarez, where he remained until the outbreak of the Mexican revolution. Mr. Edgerton is survived by a mother and a brother, Charles Edgerton, who lives in El Paso, a daughter, and a sister in Veracruz, Mexico. Funeral services will be held in the chapel of Simmons and Hartford at 2 o'clock Monday afternoon. Burial will be in Concordia cemetery. Mr. Edgerton was a member of the El Paso Elks lodge.
