

## **Mrs. Falvey, Here Since 1881, Dies**

Mrs. Rebecca Johnson Falvey, 88, pioneer resident of El Paso, died Thursday in her home in the Lower Valley. She was the widow of the late Judge T. A. Falvey, pioneer West Texas judge whose district extended from El Paso to San Antonio.

She is survived by her daughter, Mrs. Lena Falvey Lynch.

Mrs. Falvey had been a continuous resident of El Paso since 1881 and was a charter member of the First Presbyterian Church of El Paso. She was born on a plantation near Pulaski, Tenn., in 1861 and was married to Judge Falvey in San Saba, Texas, in 1880. She was a member of the Pioneer Association. She was the mother of the late Walter Falvey and Miss Mabel Falvey.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. Friday in Kaster and Maxon Chapel with the Rev. B. M. G. Williams officiating. Burial will be in Evergreen Cemetery. Pallbearers will be Gary Burdett, Malcolm Webb, Wyndham White, Herbert Hunter, Judge Ballard Coldwell and Eugene F. Smith.
