DEATH GL

Hydraulic Engineer Dies After Long Illness; Here 26 Years.

William W. Follett, one of the best known consulting engineers in the southwest, died at his home at 515 West Missouri street at 3:10 Thursday morning after an illness which had extended over a period of several years.

Born in New Sharon, Me., Mr. Follett was 58 years old at the time of his death. He was graduated from the university of Michigan in 1881 and, in 1814, was honored by the university by having the honorary degree, master of engineerings conferred upon him. He came to El Paso in 1889 from Denver, where he was a consulting engineer. He came here to take the position of consulting engineer under the geological survey in a series of investigations of the international dam proposed for the Rio Grande near El Paso.

Later he was appointed consulting engineer of the American section of the international boundary commission by Gen. Angon Mills, commissioner of the international boundary commission for more than 18 years. It has been said of Mr. Follett that no man living knew the Rio Grande in all of its twists and turns and meanderings as did W. W. Follet and he was considered an authority on water boundary matters. He was a member of the society of American Enugineers and was one of the leading hydraulic engineers of the country.
