

Lieutenant Fryer Missing in Action

2nd Lieut. Austin Edward Fryer was reported missing in action Dec. 31, the War Department has informed his parents, Mr. and Mrs. V. H. Fryer of 1008 Prospect avenue.

Lieutenant Fryer was a copilot on a B-17 bomber in England. He received his wings at Pecos Army Air Field in May, 1943. He went overseas in October, 1944.

Before entering the Air Corps in January, 1943, the 22-year-old aviator was a pre-law student at the College of Mines.

His family received a letter last week thanking them for Christmas packages and describing the Christmas dinner his colonel gave his group. He said a storm had prevented his being sent on a mission over Europe Christmas Day.
