

N. E. Galentine Dies, Aged 77

**Hotel Operator Was E. P.
Resident Nearly
60 Years.**

Norman Eddy Galentine, 77, a resident of El Paso, for nearly 60 years, died Saturday in the home of his daughter, Mrs. John McLaughlin, 1101 Galloway Avenue.

Mr. Galentine came to El Paso in 1880. He was the owner and operator of the Santa Rosalia Hot Springs resort and hotel until his retirement in 1928.
