DEATH OF WOMAN WHO SPENT FOR-TUNE DOING GOOD

Miss Refugio Garcia Passes Away in Juarez at the Age of 83, Loved and Honored By Populace.

In the death Monday night of Miss Refugio Garcia, Juarez lost one of its most loved and h nored citizens.

Miss Garcia was 83 years old. She was a member of one of the oldest and most respected pioneer families of Juarez. Her father and mother, Jesus Garcia and wife, were born in Spain and have been dead many years.

Ten or fifteen years ago Miss Garcia was worth at least \$50,000, she having inherited lands of much value in and around Juarez. All her life she had given large sums to charity, but about ten or 15 years ago she began giving more freely than ever, and at the time of her death she had given away practically all of her fortune.

She was noted for her devoutness and her faithfulness, even when very

feeble, in church attendance.

The death of Miss Garcia occurred at the home of Octaviano Garcia and wife, 30 Ugarte street, where she had lived for several years, Mr. Garcia De-

ing her nephew.

The funeral took place from that place Tuesday afternoon. Rev. Father Pinto preached an eloquent sermon in extolment of the remarkably pious life which the deceased had led and said that from beginning to end her life had been filled with nothing but good works. The interment was in the Juarez cemetery.
