
Mrs. John Montgomery, Pat Garrett's Daughter, Dies In Las Cruces

Las Cruces, N. M., Aug. 8.—The funeral of Mrs. John Montgomery was held Monday morning. Interment was made in the Catholic cemetery. She died Friday after an illness of two weeks. She was 33 years of age and is survived by her husband, three children, her mother, Mrs. P. T. Garrett, two sisters, Miss Elizabeth, who arrived from Chicago; Miss Pauline and four brothers, Poe, Pat, Oscar and Jarvis.
