

Mrs. Leonard Giles Dies; Was Pioneer

Mrs. Leonard H. Giles, 79, pioneer El Paso resident, died at her home in Troy, N. Y., Sunday, according to information received in El Paso Tuesday by Mrs. Kenneth W. MacCallum, 1815 East Rio Grande Street.

Mrs. Giles came to El Paso with her parents as a child in 1867. She was the daughter of Judge Gaylord Judd Clark, founder of St. Clement's Episcopal Church, Campbell and Montana Streets. She was prominent in social and charitable activities in New York.

Her gifts to the El Paso church include a pipe organ, given as a memorial to her father, and the Anna L. Giles Organ Endowment for the upkeep of the pipe organ.

Survivors include Henry S. Giles, Barbara, Edward and Ethelind Giles and Mrs. Henry Nichols, Chicago, Ill.

Funeral services for Mrs. Giles will be held in Troy. Burial will be in Oakland Cemetery in Troy.
