

# LAWYER-LEADER TAKEN BY DEATH

## U. S. Goen Dies While On Visit To San Francisco For Medical Treatment

The Knights of Pythias will be in charge of the funeral services in El Paso for U. S. Goen, prominent El Paso attorney who died last night in San Francisco.

Mr. Goen will be buried in El Paso. Arrangements are pending.

Relatives today requested that no flowers be sent to the funeral. Friends were asked to send, instead, Christmas offerings to the Southwestern Children's Home and the Knights of Pythias Orphanage at Weatherford, in which Mr. Goen was interested during his life.

### Went for Treatment

Mr. Goen was a former Grand Chancellor of the Knights of Pythias.

Friends of the family said today that Mrs. Ramona G. Montgomery of Austin will come to El Paso for the funeral.

### Sought Prison Farm

Mr. Goen was 61. He went to San Francisco several weeks ago for treatment by his friend, a former El Pasoan, Dr. Miley B. Wesson. His health had been failing for a year.

Mr. Goen was recognized for his interest in El Paso's progress and his charitable works. With Scott White and others he worked for location of the U. S. Detention Prison here and for the Federal building here. He was well known in Washington.

He came to El Paso to practice law in 1901 immediately after graduation from Texas University Law School. He was assistant U. S. district attorney in 1912 and 1913. He served seven years on the Civil Service Commission. He was a former president of the El Paso Bar Assn. He was a Knight of Pythias.

Mr. Goen is survived by his mother, Mrs. Sarah R. Goen of 613 East Nevada street. Mrs. Goen is visiting in Moody, Tex.
