

GOLDEN SUCCEUMBS TO HIS INJURIES

**Man Injured in Auto Accident February 23
Dies Wednesday.**

James R. Golden, a local plumber, died at Hotel Dieu Wednesday morning shortly before noon as the result of injuries sustained in an automobile accident on February 23.

Golden, Joe Barlow and A. B. Palmer were coming along the county road at Evergreen cemetery in an automobile which Palmer was driving. It ran through the fence at the cemetery and Barlow and Golden were thrown into the cemetery, Barlow being instantly killed by striking a tree.

Golden sustained a compound fracture of the right leg and other serious injuries which resulted in blood poisoning. He was removed to Hotel Dieu, where he died after lingering for several weeks.

James R. Golden, who was 27 years of age, had made his home in El Paso for the past 10 years, coming here from Mindian, Tex.

He is survived by a widow and two children, while his mother, Mrs. Ida Golden, also makes her home in El Paso. A brother, George G. Golden, also survives him, and was his partner in business.
