

# JAMES GREAVES PIONEER, DIES

**Fireman on First Steamer  
in the City Department;  
Lives Here 35 Years.**

James Greaves, 78 years of age, who was fireman on the first steam engine ever used to fight fires here, the "Belle of Waco," and for the past 35 years has resided here, working for many years for the city water works, died at a local hospital at 5 o'clock Tuesday morning.

"Uncle Jimmy," as he was known to younger El Pasoans, had none, but distant relatives in Illinois surviving him. His wife died in El Paso a number of years ago.

His funeral will be held at 4 o'clock today from the chapel of the McBean, Simmons & Hartford Undertaking company. Interment will be in the firemen's plot in Evergreen cemetery.
