Mrs. Marr's Father Dies In Accident

Returning from a farm home, where they had just attended the birth of a justy infant, Dr. Jasper Grimes, 59, father of Mrs. James L. Marr, 235 Pennsylvania avenue, and Mrs. Hazel Lee Berry, 26, nurse, were killed when their car was struck by a fast east bound train near Beaumont yesterday.

Mrs. Marr left for Beaumont last night to attend her father's funeral.

Car Burns.

The doctor and his nurse were killed when the train struck their sedan at the Vidor crossing east of the city, Associated Press dispatches said.

Mrs. Berry was thrown against a post and a gaping wound cut in the left side of her head. Her body also was burned beyond recognition in fire which broke out in the debris of the car.

Injured Internally.

Dr. Grimes' body was found several hundred feet from where the collision occurred. He is believed to have died of internal injuries caused by the crushing of his chest against the steering wheel.

Dr. Grimes had resided and practiced in Beaumont a number of years and was prominent in his profession
