

# MRS. J. W. HADLOCK DIES FRIDAY NIGHT

Wife of City Sewer Commis-  
sioner Does Not Rally  
After Operation.

Mrs. J. W. Hadlock, wife of the city sewer commissioner, died at a local hospital at midnight Friday. She underwent a serious operation on Tuesday morning and never fully recovered from the effects.

Mrs. Hadlock, nee Mary H. Cutting, was born at Stratford, Vt., nearly 69 years ago, and with her husband had resided in El Paso for the past 12 years. Last year they celebrated the 50th anniversary of their wedding and at that time there were five generations present.

She is survived by her husband, two sons, E. J. and F. D. Hadlock, their children, Damon, Minnie, Ruby and Opal Hadlock, while her granddaughter, Mrs. J. W. Carlisle, with her three daughters resides in San Diego, Calif.

Two sisters, Mrs. Louise Rollins, of Wentworth, N. H., and Mrs. Ann Meyers,

of Milford, Ia., also survive her.

The funeral will be held from the Hadlock residence in Hadlock place, just east of Washington Park, Sunday afternoon at 3 o'clock, and Rev. Miles Hanson will conduct the services.
