

Mrs. Hadlock's Rites Set; EP Pioneer

Mrs. Minnie Hadlock, 74, pioneer El Paso resident, died Friday in the home of her daughter, Mrs. Percy McGhee, 1415 North Florence Street.

Mrs. Hadlock, a resident of El Paso for 52 years, was the wife of the late E. J. Hadlock, early-day El Paso railroad engineer. She was a member of the Daughters of the King, the Pioneer Women's Association, and the Robert E. Lee chapter, Daughters of the Confederacy.
