

MOSE HARRIS, PUBLISHER, DIES HERE

Mose C. Harris, aged 79, oldest newspaper publisher in Texas, died Friday just before noon at the home of his daughter, Mrs. E. A. Henning, 4308 Oxford street.

Funeral services will be held this afternoon at the Hartford-Bruner chapel, 708 North Stanton street. Burial will be made in Evergreen cemetery.

Mr. Harris was born in Lousville, Ky., May 25, 1843. He came to Texas when a young man and was interested and associated with newspapers at Dallas, Houston, San Antonio and other cities. Last December he gave up the active management of the San Antonio Texas Republic, which he had owned for 15 years.

Besides Mrs. Henning, four other children survive. They are Miss Leah Harris, of El Paso; Mrs. R. L. McMeans, Amarillo; Jack Harris, Oklahoma City, Okla., and P. D. Harris, Waco.

Mr. Harris was a Confederate war veteran.
