Died.

On October 9th, at 10:15 a.m., at Kensett on the Sound, forty miles above New York, after a long illness, Antonio S. Hart, in the 33d year of his age.

Deceased was a brother of Mr. Hart, of the Times, and like him a native of this city, and up to the time of his death the oldest surviving son of the late Judge Simeon Hart, one of the oldest settlers of El Paso.

He had been east just one year under the care and treatment of Dr. Edwin Everett Smith, an eminent specialist, who did all that science, skill and watchfulness could accomplish to save a life which disease had irrevocably claimed. The remains will be buried temporarily at Rowayton, Connecticut.
