

# Mrs. Clara Hawkins Dies at La Luz

Funeral services for Mrs. Clara Hawkins of La Luz, N. M., who died yesterday, will be held at 4 p. m. tomorrow in La Luz Catholic Church, with Father Francos Redmon officiating. Burial will be in Tularosa Cemetery.

Mrs. Hawkins was the widow of the late William A. Hawkins, prominent El Paso and New Mexico lawyer.

She went to Carlsbad with her husband in 1893, where Mr. Hawkins opened a law office. They later moved to Silver City, and in 1904 to El Paso.

In 1926 Mr. Hawkins retired from practice and moved to La Luz.

Survivors include three daughters, Mrs. Elizabeth Wood of La Luz; Mrs. Joseph Mellen and Mrs. William Sloane, both of New York City; four sons, Ashton Hawkins of Long Island, N. Y.; John Hawkins of Carmel, N. Y.; Gardiner Hawkins of New York City, and Dr. David Hawkins of Boulder, Colo.
