Joseph Heid Taken by Death

Joseph Heid, a lifelong resident of El Paso and secretary-treasurer of the Heid Brothers Corp., died at his residence at 8564 North Loop drive today. He was 71. Mr. Heid was a member of the Immaculate Conception Church and had been active in church affairs for many years. He belonged to the Knights of Columbus Council No. 638, was a past director of the El Paso Chamber of Commerce and a past director of the El Paso Symphony Assn.

Mr. Heid was a charter member of the El Paso Historical Society and a charter member of the El Paso Pioneers Assn. He had been a member of the International Committee of the Chamber of Commerce and belonged to the El Paso BPOE Lodge and the Downtown Rotary Club.
