

A. M. HEINEMAN DIES AT LOS ANGELES HOME

Formerly Lived in El Paso For 30
Years

A. M. Heineman, Los Angeles, Cal., former El Pasoan and vice president of the Empire Products Co., died in a hospital last night, his brother, D. C. Heineman, 1137 N. Cotton Ave., was advised today He was 68.

Mr. Heineman lived in El Paso for 30 years before moving to California five years ago. He came to El Paso in 1900 as president of the Houck and Dieter Co., which has been out of existence for many years.
